

With Christ as the center of everything we do, this image of our future church, resting on the land site we've purchased is symbolic of our faith in God, our devotion to the Eucharist and our mission to serve him through His church.

The image of the sun doubles as the Eucharistic body of our Lord. The "Son" who sacrificed himself for us and our salvation.

The cup, resting on a cultivated landscape, is a symbol of the blood of Christ and also hints at the silos used to store the bounty of our rural tradition in Hampshire and Burlington.

The church, is similar to both our current building, and the design of the new church. It is shown with an open door through which the paths of our faith community will converge for generations to come.

This logo rests upon the cornerstone, a symbol of Christ, Himself. "The stone which the builder rejected has become the cornerstone." It is Christ as the cornerstone and we the living church that work to continue our sacred tradition.
